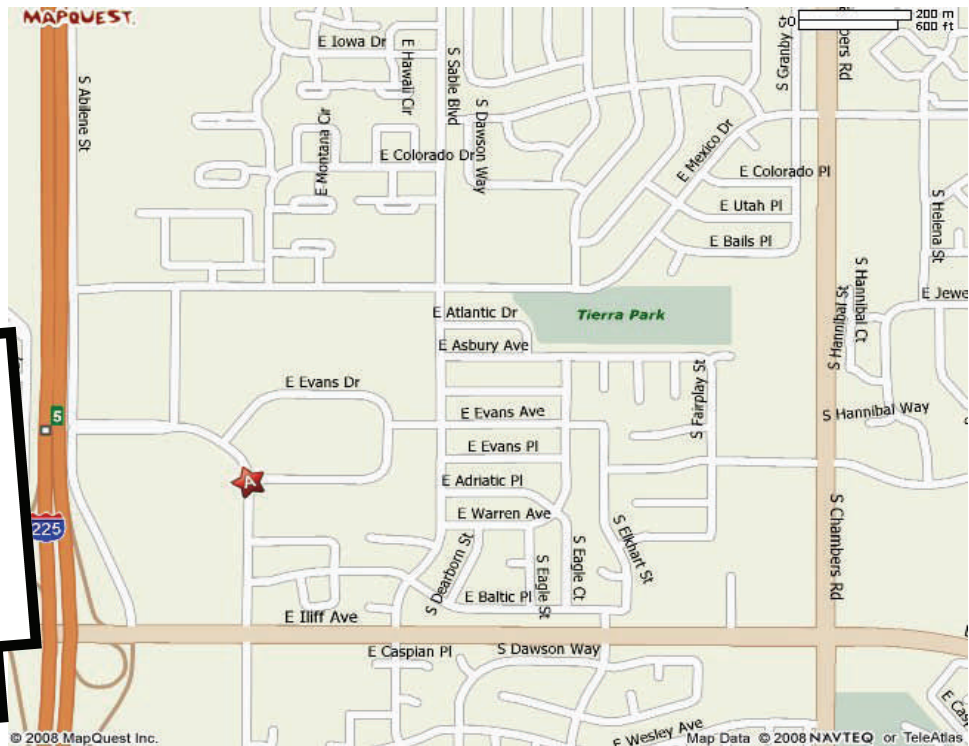

Colorado's Children Need Your Help!

Be a Court-Appointed Special Advocate!

[Colorado Casa](#) is in need of volunteers to speak up for abused, neglected or abandoned children in the court.

There are over 900 Colorado CASA volunteers paired with children statewide. Yet more CASA volunteers are needed to help over 7000 additional children who need an advocate. CASA volunteers work one-on-one with abused children, gathering information and presenting it in an objective report to the court.

CASA volunteers must be 21 years of age. Volunteers, chosen for their objectivity, competence and commitment, are screened and trained by the local CASA agencies. Being a CASA volunteer does not require any special education or background, simply the desire to help abused and neglected children find safe, permanent homes.

So what does it take to become a CASA volunteer?

- The first step: Every volunteer passes a background check and participates in a 30-hour training course.
- After successfully completing the training, the volunteer is assigned his/her first case. A volunteer's average time commitment to a case is approximately 10 hours per month.
- Volunteer advocates are asked to dedicate themselves to a case until it is closed. The average case lasts about a year to a year and a half.
- Advocates are supervised every step of the way and always have resources readily available.

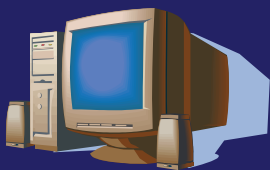

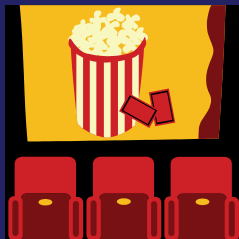

Germs

Health, level: Pre-School

Materials Required: 2 balloons, circles from hole puncher

Activity Time: 5 minutes

Concepts Taught: health



Before hand place a handful of paper hole punches inside of 2 balloons. Leave balloon number 1 deflated. Blow up balloon number 2 and tie shut. Explain to the children the importance of covering their mouth when they sneeze. Explain how germs can be spread when they allow the germs to come out of their mouth. Explain how when we use a tissue to cover our mouth the germs are caught in the tissue. Then demonstrate by taking the first balloon blow it up and pretend to sneeze and let the air out into the tissue. Show the children how the pretend germs, (paper circles) go into the tissue. Now take the second balloon and as you pretend to sneeze pop the balloon with a pencil. The germs will fly everywhere. My students loved this activity and asked to do it over and over. **IMPORTANT!** Make sure you pick up all pieces of the balloon to prevent a child from getting a piece of it.
